2014 Annual Retention Disclosure

The Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System (IPEDS) defines the “retention rate” as the rate at which students persist in their educational program at an institution, expressed as a percentage. This is the percentage of first-time degree/certificate-seeking students from the previous fall who either re-enrolled or successfully completed their program by the current fall. The data below is based on students who enrolled from August 1, 2013, through October 31, 2013, evaluated as of August 1, 2014. IPEDS collects the information on both full-time and part-time students.
